Our judges will select the winners based on four criteria:

1. Consistency
2. Acidity
3. Appearance / Appeal
4. Taste

There is a \$5 admission to the event and a \$5 entry fee for the Sauerkraut Cook-off (donations to the Arizona Center for Germanic Cultures). Along with bragging rights, prizes will be awarded to the top three contestants.
